

SCHOLARSHIPS IN THE LEGAL FIELD

The Jutta B. Spruce Scholarship Fund established by Redding Legal Professionals Association and administered by the Shasta Regional Community Foundation offers one \$500 scholarship a to qualified applicant who desires a career in the "Legal Field".

For purposes of this scholarship a career in the "legal field" shall be interpreted and defined as either (a) legal secretary (including receptionist), (b) legal assistant (including paralegal), (c) court reporter, or (d) law office administrator. SCHOLARSHIPS ARE NOT INTENDED FOR STUDENTS PLANNING TO ENTER LAW SCHOOL.

COLLEGE STUDENTS: PLAN A

Applicants shall be restricted to students who are residents of Shasta or Tehama counties that desire a career in the legal field who will have completed at least one year of college by June of the school year. Applicants will be enrolled in the fall semester immediately following the school year in a college or business school in a course of study in the legal field, until all such courses have been taken to satisfy the requirements for a degree or certificate in said legal related program.

HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS: PLAN B

Applicants shall be restricted to graduating high school seniors who are residents of Shasta or Tehama counties and who have successfully completed secretarial/business courses in high school. Applications will be enrolled in the Fall semester immediately following the school year in a college or business school offering a course of study in the legal field, until all such courses have been taken to satisfy the requirements for a degree or certificate in said legal related program.

RE-ENTRY: PLAN C

Applicants who are residents of Shasta or Tehama counties who do not qualify under Plan A or B, but who wish to pursue their education in the legal field.
